**Submissions will be judged by a panel of Educate Plus Fellows**

Judges will be asked to consider the following when judging the submissions:

- > Overall impact of the program / project on advancing the institution
- > Correlation between the purpose of the project / program and the outcomes / goals achieved
- > Creativity and innovation of the idea / program / project
- > Execution of the project / idea / program
- > Cost of the project and ROI
- > For parity the size of team / use of external consultants in the development and execution of project / program.
